Happy New Year!

Welcome back and Happy New Year from St. Patrick's Preschool! We are excited to get back to learning and playing together. This session we will learn a lot about animals, life cycles, Fairy Tales, and taking care of our planet. Learning through art, play, books and discussion help young children to internalize and connect to bigger concepts and ideas. We will also continue to encourage independence and listening skills.

A few things you can do at home to promote learning and independence:

• Encourage your child to do things that you typically do for them, like carrying dishes to the sink, picking out clothes, putting on shoes, and cleaning up toys. It might take longer but will pay off!

- Talk to your child in the car. This is a time when they are a captive audience so asking questions, pointing out signs and landmarks, and discussing where you are going and what to expect when you get there, are all great ways to bond and increase vocabulary.
- Limit screen time and read books! Reading to children has proven to increase academic success. By reading to and with your child you are increasing vocabulary, encouraging reading skills, and expanding knowledge of the world. If your child will not sit still to listen to a book, let them play quietly with a toy while you read. Some children need to be busy, but are still listening and learning.
- Include your child in daily activities like cooking, cleaning, and shopping. They will enjoy the time with you as they learn new skills.

<u>2024-25 Registration:</u> Registration will open next week for existing families, and new family enrollment will open January 15th. Tuition for the 2024-25 school year will increase slightly. The increase will go into effect at the start of our summer session. As always, if increased fees pose a hardship for your family please let us know.
