CAR SEATS

Car seats are the number one thing we can do as parents to protect our children.

Being in the correct seat for weight/height and age is the first step, but being buckled correctly with the seat installed properly is often overlooked. Bulky coats lead to loosened straps that are not always retightened, and sometimes the between the leg buckle can be a struggle.
